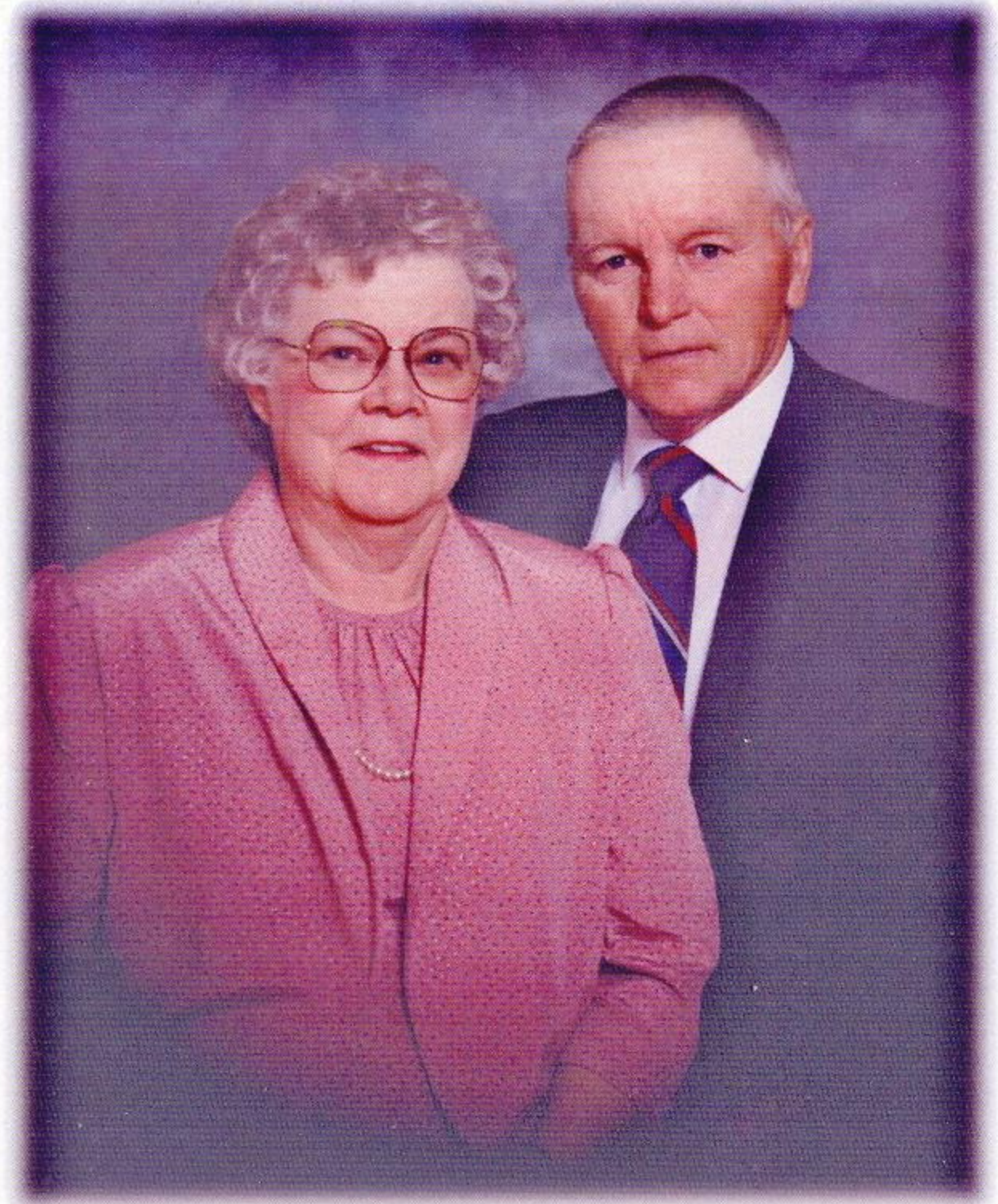

Irene was born on February 3, 1919 in Raymond where she grew up and completed her schooling. Following high school, she attended Normal School in Calgary to become a teacher. Her short teaching career found her in the classroom at Miami Colony, the Milford Colony, Beazer country school and the Raymond Elementary School.

On June 5, 1941 she married Bryant in the Alberta Temple. After their marriage, she accompanied Bryant as he was posted at various locations in Eastern Canada. She returned to Raymond when Bryant went overseas to serve his country. After the war they settled in Raymond where they worked together and raised their family. Her life was devoted to her family, church and community. Her greatest joy in life was in providing service to others.

The Funeral Service will be held on Saturday, December 4, 2010 at 2:00 p.m. at The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, KNIGHT STREET CHAPEL, Raymond, with Bishop Ron McMullin officiating. Friends may meet the family prior to the service on Saturday from 1:00 to 1:45 p.m.

Irene was born on February, 3rd, 1919 in Raymond Alberta. Her family has Swiss roots but moved here from Utah and Idaho. She is of the LDS faith and loves personal prayer and blessings on the food. Irene loves all kinds of music.

Irene remembers moving to the big stone house by the Stake Center, the one that used to be her grandfathers' home. All the girls slept in the big front bedroom on the second floor, and there were 6 of them! In school she liked math and English and did so well at school she skipped Grade 5. Summertime meant trips to Waterton, taking cows to the pasture in the mornings and playing in the canal. Two of Irene's sisters are still alive, Barbara McPhee and Guin Torrie and one brother is alive; Philip Redd.

Irene married Bryant Jensen on June 5th, 1941. and they had 8 children, 2 of whom predeceased her. Bryant passed away in 1989. They built their home together after WWII right next to the house she was raised in. Irene was a teacher then when her children began arriving she became a full time mom. She served a mission with Bryant in Ontario with natives and then another one in Salt Lake City after she was widowed.

Irene enjoys literature, sewing and piano. She will watch a musical anytime and loved to bake bread and buns. Her favourite card game was Rook and liked to play and watch basketball. She remembers Tucker, a dog she had when she was about 10 years old. When shopping Irene liked to frequent Eaton's department store. Every Sunday they had roast beef and that is one of her favourite things to eat. She likes to drink Milk and eat ice cream for dessert.
